Tegu's pouch of six magnetic wooden blocks, which come in a variety of shapes, will be a big attraction on trips. (All ages, \$30, tegu.com)



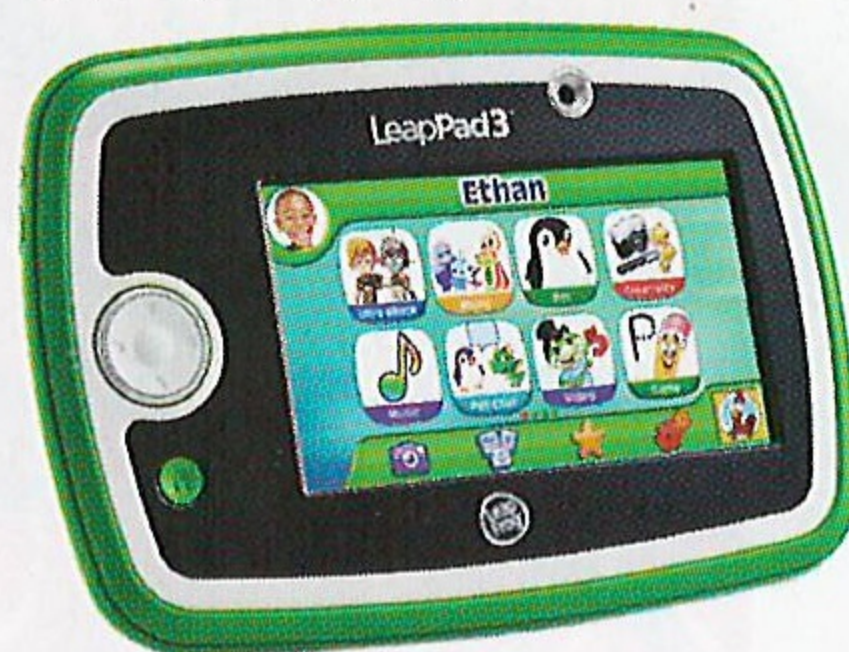
TIDY RIDE
