Chinese Import

China invades Britain with a squad of terra-cotta soldiers at London's British Museum in The First Emperor: China's Terracotta Army. The statues, originally buried in the third century BC to protect the emperor in the afterlife, are making a rare visit abroad, through April 6. At 12 soldiers and 100-plus artifacts, this is the largest terra-cotta army exhibit ever to travel outside Xi'an, China. www.britishmuseum.org
